It is our greatest desire that all persons who want to come to The Nonviolent Leadership for Social Justice Retreat be able to do so. As part of our commitment to ensuring class diversity, we do not want access to funds to be the only barrier for attendance. If you would like to attend this retreat and do not have funds to pay the requested contributions, please contact us. We would like to be in dialogue with each person interested in attending to see if together, we can identify a combination of financial assistance, fundraising, and payment plans that would enable you to attend.
